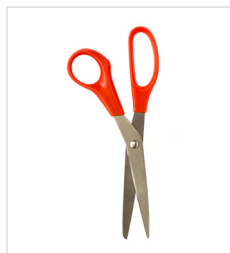


Make your own garden labels!



Here's what you'll need:

- Cardboard
- Pencils, crayons or texta's
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Clear contact (or a laminator if you have one)
- Popsicle sticks or something similar to prop up your label in the garden
- Sticky tape



How to create your garden labels:



Step 1: Colour in the labels you'll need for your garden. You can use the blank ones to make your own for other herbs or vegetables.



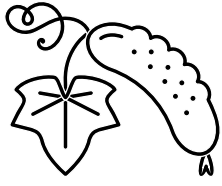
Step 2: Use the glue stick to stick the page onto a sheet of cardboard, then cut them out neatly. Ask an adult to help you with the scissors.



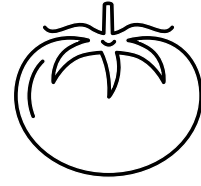
Step 3: Use the clear contact or a laminator to seal them from water in the garden. Cut around the edge leaving a gap so they are sealed.



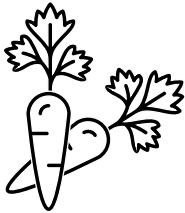
Step 4: Stick a popsicle stick to the back of each sign.



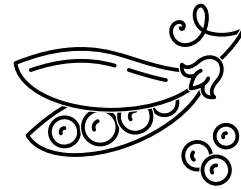
Cucumber



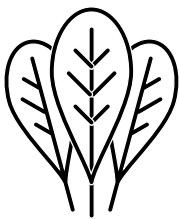
Tomato



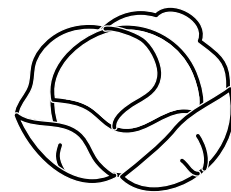
Carrot
