Drip Eze® vs Water Weeper®

If you love gardening but not the effort it takes to hand water, Pope's Drip Eze® and Water Weeper® are both great options.

By choosing the right product for your plants, you can save time and water – and enjoy all the benefits of an easy-care garden.

Drip Eze®

Applies water to plants slowly and consistently through tiny holes which aims to reach the root zone and promote strong and healthy plant growth. In-line drip tube reduces the risk of run-off and water wastage – making it perfect for snaking around intricately shaped landscape beds, laying out in a grid, or circling a plant.



Features:

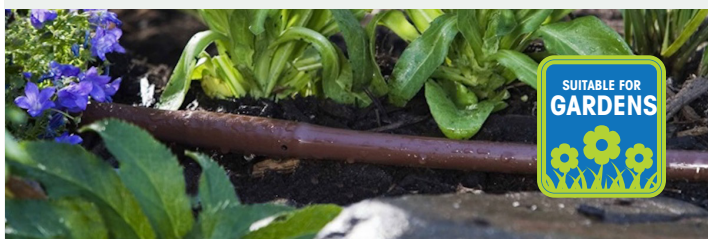
- Use 13mm Drip Eze for looping around trees and shrubs, to run from existing poly tube or replace spray jets.
- Connects to a tap or poly tube to water garden and veggie beds by using a Tail & Nut or Snap-sure connector.
- 300mm spaced emitters, 2lp/h slowly drip into your garden bed.

✔ Suitable for:

- Vegetable or herb gardens
- All soil types including sandy, loamy and clay
- Covering with mulch
- Low water pressure
- Areas up to 50m long

✘ Not suitable for:

- Non-mains water tank connections and non-potable water
- Slopes
- Pots or hanging baskets



Water Weeper®

Offering easy-to-use rollout drip watering that connects directly to your garden hose, the Water Weeper 'weeps' through randomly formed holes. This results in a higher flow rate which can be great for larger plants with higher water requirements. The option of a fitted flow regulator allows the user to adjust the amount of water flow.



Features:

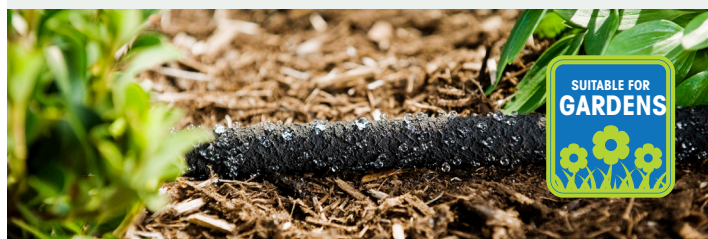
- 4mm connects to 13mm poly pipe, making it ideal for looping around trees and shrubs.
- 12mm connects to a garden hose to gently soak garden beds and borders.
- Adjust how much water your plants receive with the flow regulator - 1/4, 1/2, 3/4 or full.

- Garden beds, hedges and nature strips
- All soil types including sandy, loamy and clay
- Covering with mulch
- Low water pressure
- Connecting to garden hose

✘ Not suitable for:

- Non-mains water tank connections and non-potable water
- Slopes
- Pots or hanging baskets
- Vegetable or herb gardens

Add a Pressure Reducer to easily bring the incoming water pressure down to 100 or 300kPa.
